



**“THE CADRE PROGRAM”**  
*Comprehensive Alcohol and Drug  
Reduction Education*

***What is the CADRE Program?***

The **CADRE** Program is the Hart District’s three tiered program designed to provide drug awareness/education; prevention/intervention programs and counseling support to our students and parents who want to be a part of the solution to prevent, reduce and rid our schools of illegal substance use and abuse by minors.

**CADRE Drug Awareness and Education**

**Tier 1 - CADRE** Drug Awareness and Education includes parent and student seminars which are presented at neighborhood school and are designed to educate students and parents about the types of drugs being used and

abused in our school community and how to detect signs of drug or alcohol use.

**CADRE Counseling Support**

**Tier 2 - CADRE** counseling support comes in the form of a free initial consultation with an approved licensed drug counselor when drug use has been detected. The **CADRE** program provides this support to families free of charge.

**CADRE Voluntary Testing**

**Tier 3 - CADRE** voluntary random drug testing is another free service provided to students and families who want to:

- Have a say in preventing and treating students who use illegal substances, i.e. drugs, alcohol, prescription medications and/or steroids.
- Promote a safe and drug-free school
- Give students a reason to say **NO** to drug use.

- Encourage responsible decision making
- Be a part of a greater solution
- Potentially save lives.

***How do I enroll in the CADRE program?***

**CADRE** is completely voluntary. Enrollment forms are available on the Hart District website link at [www.hartdistrict.org/cadre](http://www.hartdistrict.org/cadre) or on your neighborhood school’s web site. Enrollment forms can also be picked up at all district sites at the receptionist desk. Parents can complete the form and return it to the school, to the district office receptionist or mail it to the address on the enrollment form.
