• **Mix It Up Day**

- Hart recognized as a model district of this national program
- Students across the district engaged in activities to break down social barriers.

• **Youth Summit**

- Collaborative effort between the District and the City of Santa Clarita
- 350 junior high school students from District and Castaic Middle School brought together for a day of “social bridge-building”
- Peer leadership activities conducted by students from West Ranch HS and Valencia HS

• **Museum of Tolerance**

- The entire Saugus 9th grade class (over 800 students)
- Individual classes from Bowman, Canyon and Sierra Vista

• **Operation Us – Canyon High School**

- 40 CHS students were trained to present diversity assemblies to 6th graders.
- 5 elementary schools in the Sulphur Springs District participated.
- 450 students attended the assemblies.

• **Operation Us – Rio Norte Junior High School**

- 84 RNJHS students were trained to present diversity assemblies to 3rd graders.
- 5 elementary schools in the Saugus Union District participated.
- 675 students attended the assemblies.

• **Safe School Ambassadors –**

- More than 300 students across ten campuses are working among their peer groups to reduce intergroup tensions, increase social inclusion and promote a general atmosphere of respect for all students.
- Rancho Pico JHS implemented SSA this year, bringing the number of participating campuses to 11.

- **SHARE Tolerance Trailer – LA County Sheriff’s Dept.**
 - 641 10th graders at Saugus HS
 - 820 9th graders at West Ranch HS

- **STRIVE – Valencia High School**
 - 42 VHS students were trained to present diversity lessons to 6th graders.
 - 23 classrooms in 7 elementary schools in the Newhall and Saugus elementary school districts were visited.
 - 690 students were visited in their classroom.
 - STRIVE students taught workshops at the annual Youth Summit program for junior high school students.

- **Student Task Force – Canyon and Valencia**
 - Students from Canyon and Valencia hosted the Children’s Rights Camp.
 - AOC and Hart have recently begun school chapters of STF.
 - Students are facilitating a student and educators survey, to be used as part of a Harvard University School of Education research project. Hart District is being considered as the representative school district for the western United States.

- **Addressing Costs of Co-curricular Programs**
 - For 2011-12, administrators tasked with reviewing program costs and manner in which information about costs is communicated to parents.
